

When will you become a "4t5'er"?®



SET UP:

- Set up balls between pocket openings with base of ball 1 inch from edge of slate, as shown above.
- Left handed players will reverse the placement of the 1&3, 5&6, 2&4 balls.

HOW TO PLAY "4t5" ®

- Place the cue ball anywhere on the table to begin.
- Balls must be pocketed in consecutive order (1-9).
- 7, 8, 9 balls must be called shots.
- No masse or jump shots are allowed... Kick to a rail only!
- Your inning ends with a missed shot, or cue ball coming in contact with any other ball besides your target ball.
- If you foul/scratch but you pocket your target ball, the points do not count.
- All 9 balls are reset at the end of each inning for next player.
- At the end of each inning, add up face value of balls pocketed and record score.
- 1 game is 10 innings.
- A perfect inning is "4t5"®, a perfect game is 450.
